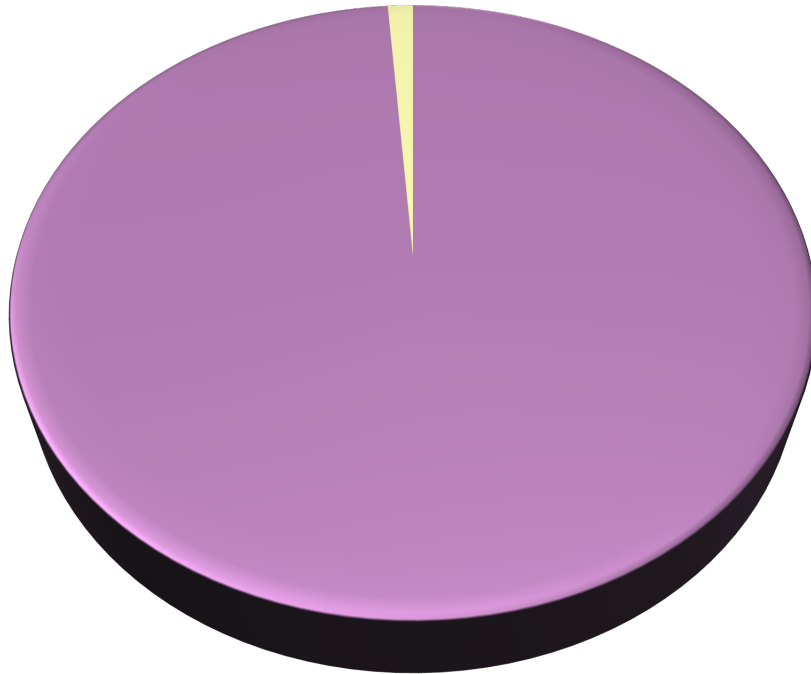

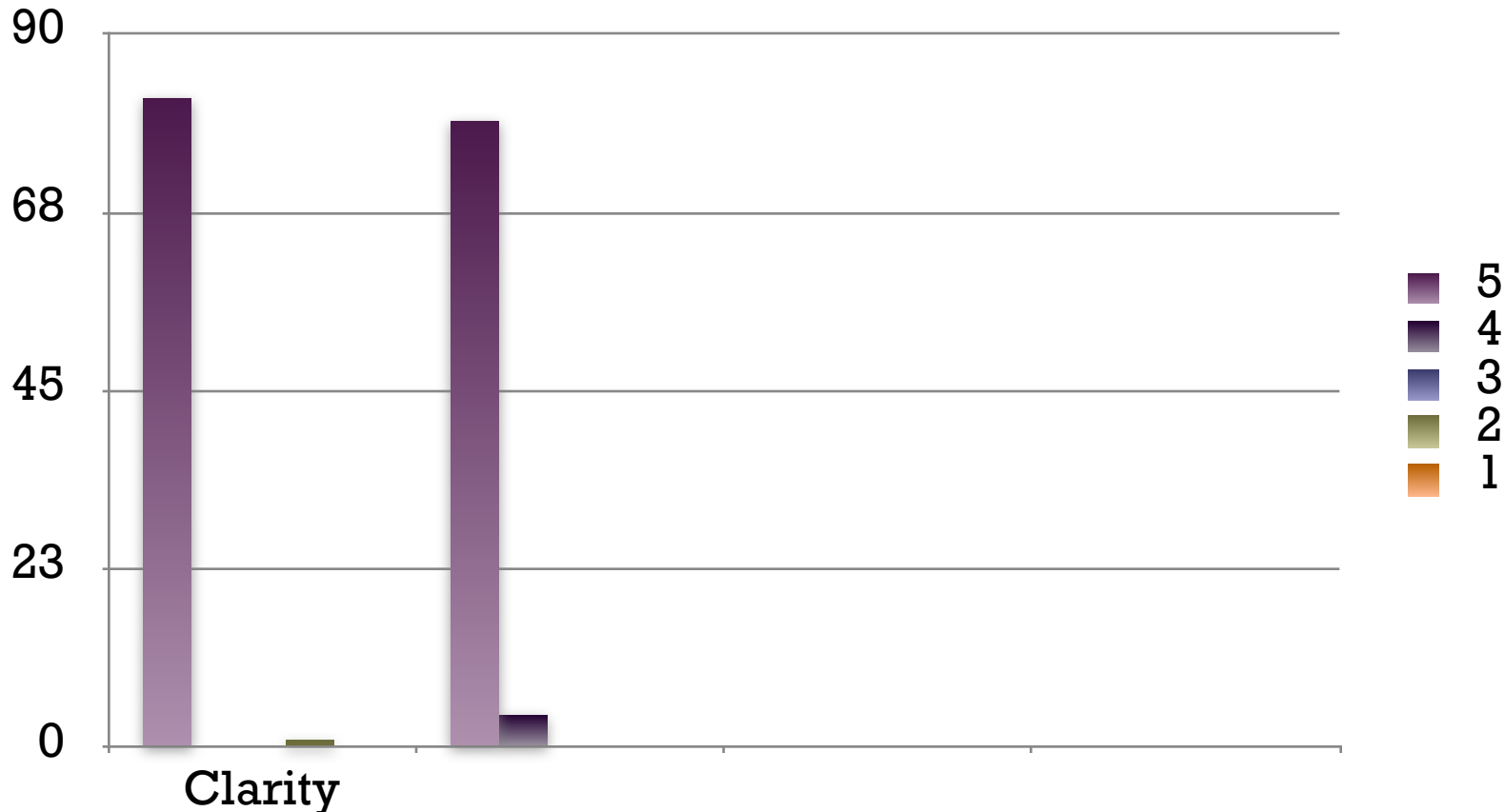

82 responses for Excellent, 1 satisfactory

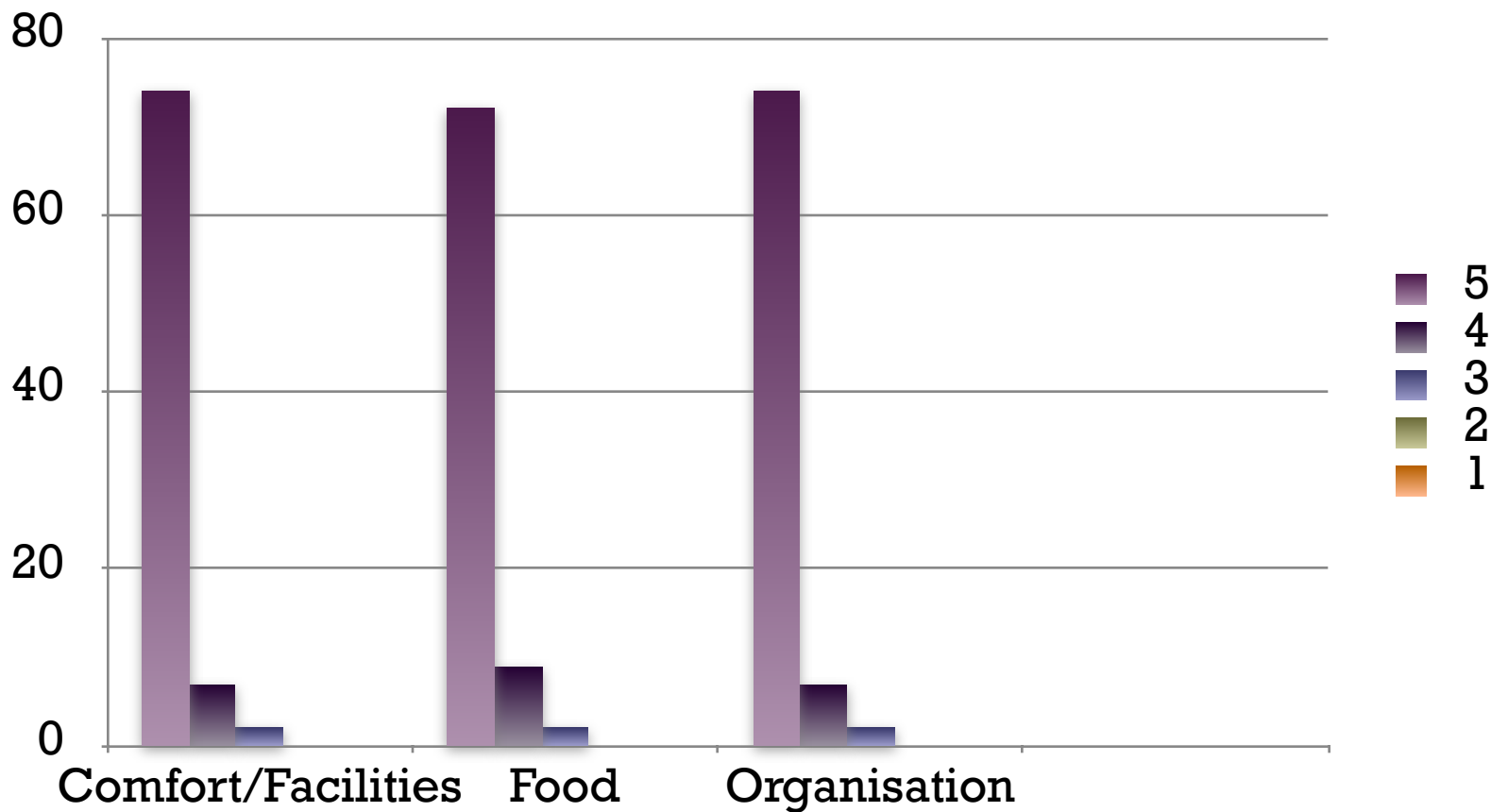
+ Workshop Feedback

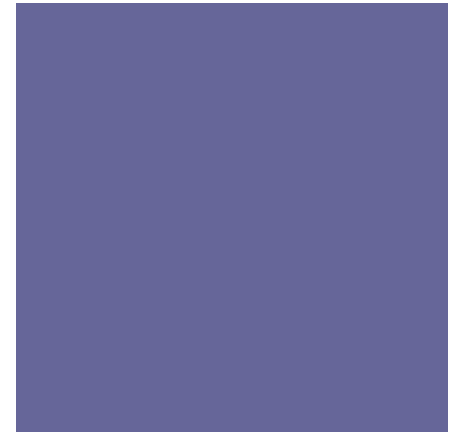
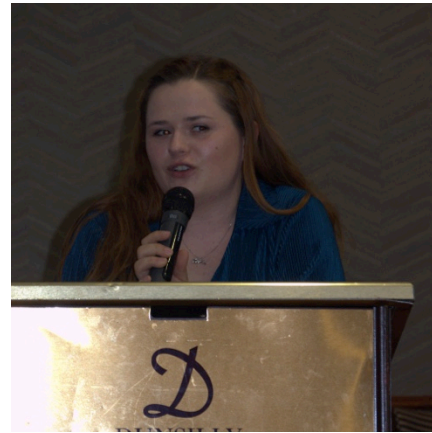
